Here at Whitchurch Primary we have a strong PE department and a record of excellence in sports, especially Athletics.

2015-16

We have a lot planned for 2015-2016 and predict that it will be another, even better year of sporting achievements. Here are some achievements that we have already had so far this year:

- Our approach for intra-school competition, particularly the recording of it, has been noted as a key strength of our physical education program by the local authority and it will be shared with other local PE co-ordinators
- Organised and led the Harrow Sportshall Athletics Competition for other Harrow Schools
- Coaches from the following clubs have been to school to offer coaching/taster sessions to pupils and support for our teachers: Harrow Hockey Club, London Broncos RFC, Watford and Barnet FC
- We are developing the role of the school sports committee including having reporters at all of our sports fixtures
- To help build excitement and anticipation for Rio 2016, we have decided to change our team names: Jonnie Peacock (red), Katarina Johnson-Thompson (green), Hannah Cockcroft (yellow) and Adam Gemili (blue)
- Have trialled new plans for EYFS physical development and KS1 physical education
- Real PE is designed to develop agility, balance, co-ordination, healthy competition and co-operative learning and fully meets the needs of the new curriculum
- Harrow Champions in Sportshall Athletics and Hockey (so far!)
- We will be representing Team Harrow in the London Youth Games Hockey competition and the West London Sportshall Athletics finals
- We will be hosting the Harrow Dance Showcase at the Harrow Arts Centre again in March.

2014-15

2014-2015 proved to be another fantastic year for Sport at Whitchurch. Below are some of the key achievements.

- Awarded the Gold School Games Kitemark
- Provision for disability sport improved through CPD for staff and new plans for pupils and implemented across Key Stage 2
- Participation in Level 1 intra-school sport increased to 100% of pupils competing in 11 different sports
- Participation in Level 2 inter-school sport increased to 70% of pupils by the time they left Year 6 (11 different sports)
- 246 free extra-curricular sports club places offered
- 51% of KS2 pupils involved in extra-curricular sport every week
- 33% of KS2 pupils were involved in sports leadership
- Redesigned and successfully implemented more inclusive Sports Day format
- Harrow Champions in Quadkids Athletics and Table Tennis
- Represented Team Harrow in the London Youth Games Quadkids Athletics competition
- Championed disability sports provision in Borough Sports Athletics competition for the first time, linked to school's equality objectives
- Largest ever Harrow Dance Showcase run by Whitchurch Primary School with over 500 children across the borough participating.
