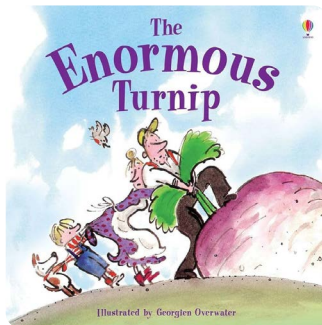
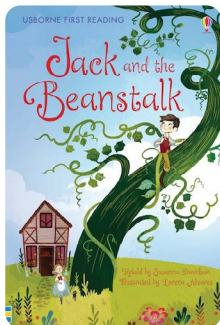


Literacy

Jack and the Beanstalk / The Enormous Turnip

We will be reading a variety of stories related to growing such as 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and 'The Enormous Turnip'. We will produce imaginative pieces of writing, speech bubbles, instructional writing for growing, story maps and sequencing.



Understanding the World

Growing Plants

We will learn about growing plants, how to grow seeds or beans and how to care for them to ensure growth. We will observe and describe changing weather patterns and their effects on people, animals and plants.



Communication and Language

We will learn how to listen for longer periods of time in different situations. We will learn key vocabulary related to growing and change and explore storytelling through story maps, sequencing and by having extended conversations.

Plants

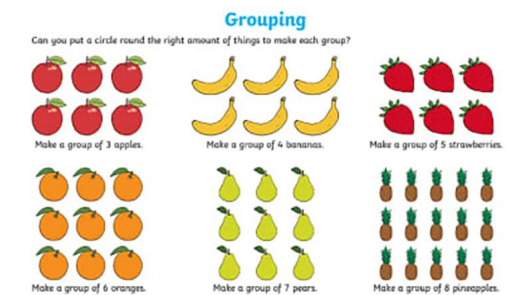
We will create artwork inspired by different types of plants. We shall also act out scenes from traditional stories and enhance these using props and music.

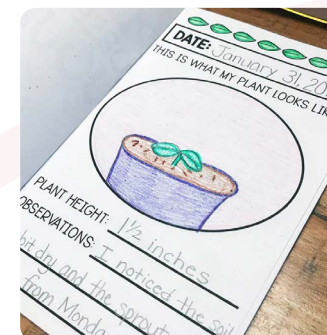
Personal, Social and Emotional Development
