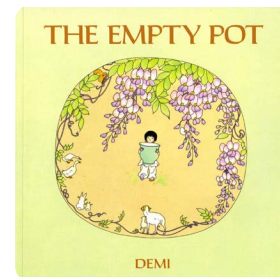


English

'The Empty Pot' by Demi

We shall be reading 'The Empty Pot', learning to make predictions, explore new vocabulary and understand the moral of the story. We will learn about features of a newspaper and write a newspaper report. We will also learn how to write a book review.



Science

Health and Hygiene

We will learn about the importance of exercise for keeping our bodies healthy, the role of a healthy diet in maintaining good health, and the importance of hygiene in staying clean and preventing illness.



Music

Singing Games

In Music, we will focus on singing games and explore both their musical and physical characteristics. Pupils will also learn to play the melodies of these games and accompany them with simple rhythms.

History

Exploring London: Then and Now

We will explore the history of London and learn how it has changed over time. We will compare transport from the past with transport today, and also look at how people's lifestyles have changed from the past to the present.



Art and Design

Clay Sculptures

We will explore how to use clay and develop our skills through hands-on activities. We will create a famous London landmark using clay and then evaluate our work by explaining the techniques and skills we used.



Religious Education

Prayer

We will learn about prayer in Christianity and Judaism, exploring how and why people pray. We will compare prayer in different religions to understand similarities and differences.

PSHE

Changing Me

We will learn about life cycles in nature and how living things grow and change over time. We will explore how humans grow from young to old and reflect on the changes we experience as we grow, as part of understanding 'Changing Me'.

Maths

Position and Direction

We will learn to collect and represent data in different ways, such as bar charts, tally charts, and pictograms. We will also use the language of position to describe movement and turns, and explore shape patterns that involve turns and direction.

French

Pets

We will be learning about pets and describing their physical features.

Physical Education

Gymnastics / Athletics

We will develop our gymnastics skills by learning to sequence balances, shapes, rolls, and jumps. In athletics, we will focus on improving our techniques in jumping, running, and throwing.
