English

'Song of the River' by Gill Lewis

We will be using the beautiful text Song of the River by Gill Lewis to inspire our writing. We will explore rich vocabulary to describe characters and settings from the story, write diary entries from different perspectives, and develop persuasive writing skills through letters and promotional texts.



Science Light

During our topic on Light, we will investigate how we see things, how light reflects off surfaces, and how shadows are formed and change size. Through hands-on experiments, we will develop our scientific enquiry skills by asking questions, making predictions, observing closely, and recording patterns.



Music **Recorder Skills**

In Music, we will continue developing our recorder playing skills. Pupils will learn an additional note, C, and will revisit and refine the pieces learned so far in preparation for an end of term concert.

History The Anglo Saxons

In History we will be learning about life in Anglo-Saxon times. We will compare the Celts, Romans, and Anglo-Saxons, explore what life was like in their settlements, and discover the meanings behind Anglo-Saxon place names.

Design Technology Sewing

In Design Technology, we will be learning how to sew using crossstitch and appliqué. We will design, decorate, and assemble our own monster inspired cushions, and finally evaluate our finished products.

We will explore Jain, Hindu, Christian, and Muslim pilgrimages, including the Haj, and learn about the activities involved. We will also reflect on the experiences of pilgrims and what pilgrimage means to people of faith.
