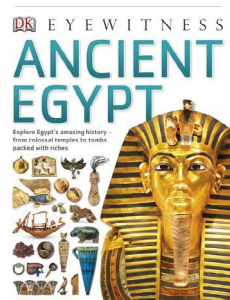


## English

### Non-Fiction Texts

We will be learning to write a setting description of a tomb as well as a narrative about an Egyptian adventure inside a tomb including a beginning, middle and an end. The skills will focus around figurative language and the five senses as well as varying sentence starters and fronted adverbials.



## Science

### Teeth / Digestive System

In Science will learn to identify and classify herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. We will construct and interpret a variety of food chains. We shall also explore different ways of keeping teeth healthy and name and investigate the different parts of the digestive system.



## Music

### Clarinets and Trumpets

In Music, we will focus on playing pieces that incorporate all the notes and note values learned throughout the year. Emphasis will be placed on following dynamic markings and performing pieces in a variety of styles.

## History

### The Egyptians

What were the achievements of the Ancient Egyptians? We will learn about the Ancient Egyptian civilisation and where it fits in relation to Britain's timeline. We will learn about what life was like and the civilisation's achievements.



## Design Technology

### Construction

We will explore frame structures and design a pavilion. We will build our own pavilion and develop their construction skills by adding cladding to our finished structure.



## Religious Education

### Fasting

In R.E. we will explore the concept of fasting and why people fast. We will investigate food and fasting as part of the religious practices. We shall also learn about fasting in Islam and compare it with fasting in Hinduism and Christianity.

## PSHE

### Changing Me

In PSHE we will be exploring changes to our bodies including girls and puberty. We shall consider being unique, confidence in change, accepting change and preparing for transition.

## Maths

### Time / Shape / Charts

In Maths we will learn about time, days of the week and months of the year. We will also learn about shapes, angles and symmetry, how to draw and interpret charts and about co-ordinates.

## French

### Hobbies

In French we shall be discussing indoor and outdoor hobbies and how frequently we do them.

## Physical Education

### Athletics / Swimming

In Athletics we will develop running, jumping and throwing techniques - achieving speed, distance and accuracy. In Swimming we shall develop confidence in the water and learn a range of strokes to develop our swimming technique.
