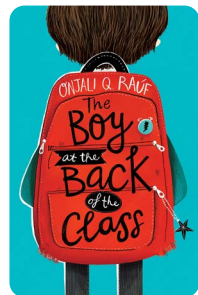


English

In English, we will explore the powerful story 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' through drama, discussion, and imaginative writing. We'll make predictions, write letters, narratives, poems, and reflections to understand characters' feelings and relationships.



Science

Materials and their Properties

In Science, we will be exploring materials and their properties, including their states and characteristics such as hardness, flexibility, and transparency. We will investigate solubility and dissolving, learn how to separate mixtures and explore the differences between reversible and irreversible changes.



Music

Rounds and Singing

In Music, we will sing three part rounds with pitch accuracy, play two part rounds on tuned percussion instruments, as well as play major and minor chords.

Geography

Time Zones

In Geography, we will explore key lines of significance such as the Equator, Tropics, and Prime Meridian, as well as time zones and their global impact. Using maps, globes, and digital tools, we'll locate countries and understand how Earth's geography affects day, night, and time differences.



Art and Design

In Art, we will develop our observational drawing skills by sketching real-life during our trip to Buckingham Palace. Inspired by artist Stephen Wiltshire, we will create detailed drawings and explore collage and mono printing techniques based on our own observations.



Religious Education

Sikhism

In Religious Education, we will investigate different forms of commitment. We will also learn about key Sikh beliefs and explore traditions such as weddings and pilgrimages to the Golden Temple.

PSHE

Being Me in My World

In PSHE, we will explore new challenges, set personal goals and reflect on our rights and responsibilities both in school and as citizens of our country. We will also learn how our behaviour affects others and understand the importance of making good choices.

Maths

Number and Place Value

In Maths, we will deepen our understanding of number and place value by working with numbers up to 1,000,000. We shall explore Roman numerals, powers of 10, and use number lines and partitioning to build confidence.

French

Weather and Climate

In French, we will learn about different types of weather and temperatures. We will also explore different countries and continents.

Physical Education

Outdoor Adventure Activities / Tag Rugby

In Physical Education, we will focus on developing communication, teamwork, and problem-solving skills through Outdoor Adventurous Activities. We will also develop our understanding of tag rugby - developing tactics such as passing backwards and defending as a team.
