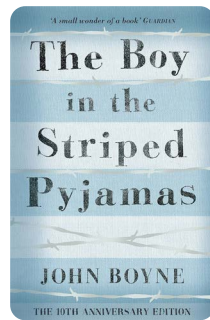


English

'The Boy in Striped Pyjamas' by John Boyne

In English we will be learning to analyse a key character's traits and drawing inferences from a text. We will explore the features of a monologue, write their own monologue and share it with their peers. We will review how to create imagery using figurative language and use these skills to write a setting description.



Science

Animals including humans

In Science we will be learning to work scientifically by exploring scientific research about the relationship between our bodies and diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle.



Music

Music Theory and Melodic Composition

In Music, we will understand staff notation, play triads (major and minor chords) and also compose melodies over a four chord sequence.

History

World War II

In History we will be learning to understand the key events which led to the outbreak of World War II, discovering which countries were involved and which groups of people were affected.



Design Technology

Sewing

In DT we will use a combination of sewing skills to create a waistcoat design.



Religious Education

Christianity

We will explore the question: Is Christianity still a strong religion 2000 years after Jesus was on earth? We will understand the strength, guidance and the motivation that Christianity give to the people in order to lead good lives.

PSHE

Being Me in My World

We will identify our goals for this year by understanding and expressing our fears and worries about the future. As global citizens, we will revise the universal rights for all children and will understand how democracy and the voice of pupils impacts the school community.

Maths

Place Value

In Maths we will be learning about numbers to one million followed by numbers up to ten million. We will review negative numbers, common factors and multiples of a number.

French

Appearance and Personality

In French we will learning to describe appearance, personality and jobs for ourselves and family members.

Physical Education

Gymnastics

We will learn how to use variations in level, direction and pathway. We will also learn how to combine and link actions and how to relate to a partner and apparatus when developing sequences.
